Approval of Minutes – 1/21/2026: Motion to approve the minutes was brought by Molly (Kelsey); the motion was passed without opposition.

Approval of Agenda: Molly (Kelsey) moved to approve the agenda. The motion passed without opposition.

PSA Announcements: Suggestions include MS, Colorectal cancer, and nutrition. Molly reported that February posts were about National Heart Month and Eating Disorders.

2026 Projects/Programs: Farmer’s Market for May, per usual; Teresa will check for availability in March. Open House in October. “Are You Okay” Series discussed. Continued work with CARES, Dungeon Fitness, back-to-school picnic, and Goodfellows. Members asked Teresa to provide past surveys the committee has used to model one to use at events this year.

“Are You Okay” Series: Lineup- Monthly to Start, Saturday mornings, 90-minute block; Victor to be first speaker for April on Teen Mental Health. The commission will continue on the First Saturday of the Month through the summer session, starting at 10 am. Teresa has booked the Carlow Room (April 4, May 3, June 6) at Costick for the events. Ikram is coordinating with speakers. Other ideas discussed- Senior isolation, caregivers, senior scams.

FH Feeding Taskforce program: Teresa sent out information on these meetings. All commissioners welcome. March 9 at 2:00 is the next meeting. Molly plans to attend. The commission members expressed a desire to become involved with this task force.

Farmer's Market: Cannot be scheduled until March.

March Officer Elections: In March, we will vote for our new Chair, Co-Chair, and Secretary positions. Molly discussed the role of Chair and let the commission know that she will not seek another term. She encouraged all commissioners to think about becoming a leader in the commission and to contact her or Charlie if they had questions about the role.

Self Defense Training: Farah was not present but sent a report. The police officer has agreed to do the training. She needs at least two weeks' advance notice to do the class. The class will have a maximum of 25 participants. Farah will continue working with her to schedule this. It will be held at Costick and open to the public.

Member Comments/Announcements: Teresa reported that there are 66 unhoused families and 6 older adults currently living at Motel 6.
