TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Farmington Hills who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, October 19, 2020**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in-person with proof of residency (MCL168.492) at the City of Farmington Hills Clerk's Office, located at 31555 W. 11 Mile Road, Farmington Hills, MI 48336 at the following times:

- Regular business hours: Monday through Friday from 8:30am to 4:30pm

STATE PROPOSAL 20-2

A proposed constitutional amendment to require a search warrant in order to access a person's electronic data or electronic communications.
