City of Farmington Hills Launches Community Survey Examining 12 Mile and Orchard Lake Corridors

The City is seeking feedback from community members, business and property owners, and visitors, regarding their experience in these business corridors

FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich. (Jan. 28, 2025) – The City of Farmington Hills is seeking input from community members through an online survey regarding the 12 Mile and Orchard Lake Corridors. The survey, which is part of a groundbreaking market study aimed at boosting the City’s economic growth, is available at [FHgov.com](https://www.fhgov.com).

The 12 Mile Corridor stretches from Orchard Lake Road to Haggerty Road and the Orchard Lake Corridor runs from Oakland Community College Orchard Ridge Campus, just south of I-696, to 14 Mile Road. Anyone who lives in, works in, visits, commutes through, or owns a business or property in these two important business corridors will be able to provide input on their experiences and priorities for the City to consider, as it relates to these areas.

“Thousands of people access these corridors each week, and we want to ensure that any future advancement reflects the community’s needs,” said Cristia Brockway, economic development director for the City of Farmington Hills. “Input from the survey will be used to help existing businesses and potential developers find the best areas in the City to meet their growth needs, with respect to what we hear from the public.”

The open-ended survey includes specialized questions for various users of the corridors, including residents, visitors, workers, business owners and property owners, to gain insight on what changes and improvements different stakeholders would like to see. With that in mind, the survey is available in multiple languages, including Arabic, Chinese, Hindi and Japanese. The survey is anonymous with the option for participants to include their email.
